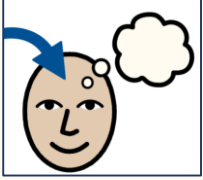

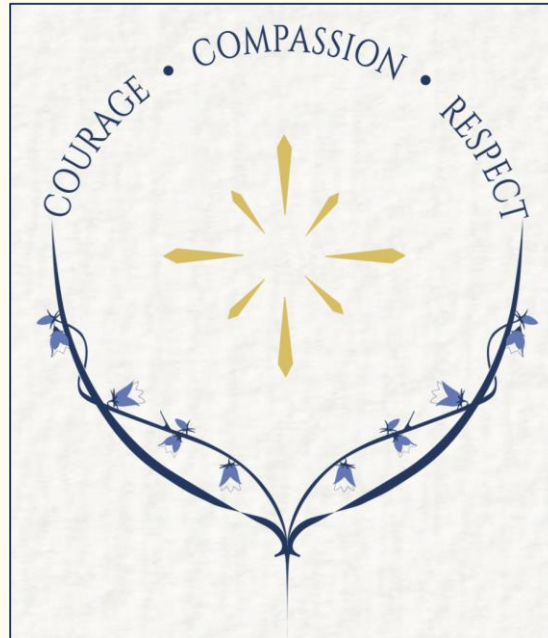
Excellence in Learning 24/25
